No. 78/1), Srigandanagar, Near Hegganhalli Cross, BBMP Ward NO 70, Vishwaneedam Post, Bengaluru Urban-560091, Karnataka for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 60 seats for the academic year 2024-2025 regarding.

Sir,

Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Karnataka is functional since 2019 and has applied for permission for continuing of BHMS course with intake capacity of 60 seats for the academic year 2024-25. The College Part 1 information has been received for information on compliance to MSR 2013. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Standards Requirements to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under clause 28 of NCH Act 2020.

On careful examination of Part 1 information & inspection conducted on (20.6.2024 & 21.6.2024), the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed following shortfall.

1. Miscellaneous

- Adhaar enabled biometric attendance system (AEBAS) is not implemented. This may be enabled within a period of one month.
- Acquittance and Attendance of Guest Faculty is not uploaded. College shall submit attendance & acquittance of guest faculty for past 3 months.
- Acquittance and Attendance of modern medicine consultant is not uploaded. College shall submit attendance & acquittance of modern medicine consultant for past 3 months.

2. Inspection remarks

- Manual central and IPD register is not available. No case papers were not available in OPD for verification, while interviewing with medical officer they told only computerised printed case papers is available. No manual OPD case papers were maintained.
- MO in the ward was unable to identify the repetition of medicine in IPD patients
- Clinical evaluation of the presenting complaints is incomplete in all cases.
- Chronic complaints case taking is not done as per the chronic case record perform of IPD.

IPD and OPD case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as Name, Age, Sex, Address, Phone number, etc. Diagnosis of the case shall be recorded as per ICD 11 criteria. All follow up attendance should be recorded on the case records. Case sheets shall be maintained with complete case history, analysis and evaluation and repertorisation and made available in Medical Record Room for academic purpose of students and follow up of patients.

Considering the above observations and facilities available, MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional Permission to Anuradha Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Sy.No.78/5 (Old Sy.No.78/1), Sriganadanagar, Near Hegganhalli Cross, BBMP Ward NO 70, Vishwanedam Post, Bengaluru Urban-560091, Karnataka for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 60 seats for the academic year 2024-2025**


All deficiencies noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification.

It is further to mention that all admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 UG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or s the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.

The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

Permission to college can be withdrawn or denied in the subsequent year if college is found deficient in compliance to MSR 2013 anytime during the academic year.


